- c) undertake to comply with the Intermodal Safe Container Transportation Act and such other applicable rules and regulations in relation to the weight of the Goods ("the Applicable Rules");
- d) undertake to pay for any and all penalties, levies, charges, costs and taxes due or payable under the Applicable Rules;
- e) undertake to indemnify OOCL and hold OOCL harmless in respect of any liability, loss, damage or expense which you may sustain as a result of us breaching any of the Applicable Rules and/or making any false, inaccurate or incomplete certification hereunder.
