Objective

- Interim ISM audit was carried out for Container vessel M.V OLIVIA which changed flag from Antigua and Barbuda to The Portuguese Republic at Guangzhou Wenchong Shipyard Co Ltd. China while under dry dock repair operation.
- 2. Owner name: MS Olivia Schifffahrtsgesellschaft mbH & Co. KG, Managing Company name: TB Marine Cont Shipmanagement GmbH & Co. KG.
- Interim DOC for owner operator was issued by ABS under the authority of the government of The Portuguese Republic, valid until 23 October 2018. Copy of DOC was observed on board.
- 4. Company policy was signed by fleet Manager and posted at Bridge and Mess Room and ECR.
- 5. Mr. Daniel Thaeter was assigned as DPA and 24 hours contact number provided.
- 6. Statutory Certificates were available on board & found valid.
- 7. Crew complement was in excess of requirement of Safe Manning Certificate.
- 8. All crews were checked with suitable competency certificate.
- 9. The Master and Senior Officers were interviewed and found familiar with SMS and the planned arrangement for SMS implementation.
- 10. Essential instructions such as lifeboat station and responsibilities, fire station responsibilities, oil pollution responsibilities and pertinent requirements from the SOLAS training manual, were provided prior to sailing.
- 11. The station bills for lifeboat, firefighting emergency and oil pollution for were posted and through the interview the crews showed themselves familiar with emergency action.
- 12. Internal audit of shipboard SMS was planned and to be carried out prior to 20 April 2018.
- 13. The working language on board was English and company manuals were written in English.
- 14. Declaration of Company and declaration of DPA were verified on board.
- 15. Walkabout was carried out without finding.
- 16. At the end of the audit, an Interim Safety Management Certificate was issued on behalf of Flag State valid until 22-July-2018.
