Subject: “Clean On Board” Clause

Under International Chamber of Commerce’s UCP600, Article 27 stated – *A bank will only accept a clean transport document. A clean transport document is one bearing no clause or notation expressly declaring a defective condition of the goods or their packaging. The word “clean” need not appear on a transport document, even if a credit has a requirement for that transport document to be “clean on board”.*

With reference to above, a set of Bill of Lading, therefore is deemed “clean” in the absence of any additional clause on the face of this shipping document.
