- I. Terminal operations will be on regular schedule (overnight receiving)
- II. Container depot schedule as follows:
 - i.) Trans Ocean (TOCSI)
 - Will be opened from 0800hrs to 1700hrs
 - ii.) ATI
 - On regular schedule
- III. Chassis depot schedule as follows:
 - i.) Transcom chassis depot
 - Closed
 - ii.) QP Marine chassis depot
 - Will be opened from 0800hrs to 1700hrs
