**Terminals, Container and Chassis Depot Operations 3<sup>rd</sup> Update**

Dear Valued Customer(s),

We are writing to inform you of the following updates in terminal, container and chassis depot operations due to typhoon Yolanda (international code name: Haiyan).

- I. Terminal operations
  - Manila North Harbour (MICT) operations have been suspended at 1500hrs today until further notice.
  - Manila South Harbour operations have been suspended until further notice.
- II. Container depot schedule as follows:
  - i.) Trans Ocean (TOCSI)
    - Operations have been suspended until further notice.
  - ii.) ATI
    - Operations have been suspended until further notice.
- III. Chassis depot schedule as follows:
  - i.) Transcom chassis depot
    - Operations still ongoing
  - ii.) QP Marine chassis depot
    - Operations still ongoing

In addition, Bureau of Customs (BOC) suspended its office at 1500hrs today.

We will keep you posted whenever there are further changes on their operations.
