Safety First - Battery Powered and Hybrid Vehicles

With an increase in shipments for battery-powered and hybrid vehicles, it is important to understand key differences compared to traditional vehicles, risk factors, and classification requirements.

What information does OOCL ask for?

To protect all stakeholders in an export transaction, we will request the accompanying MSDS, DG Certificate, Schedule B number, HS Code, and may ask for photographs to validate vehicle classification.

What is cargo misdeclaration?

OOCL differentiates between two types of misdeclarations: commodity and dangerous goods.

Commodity misdeclarations apply when a cargo commodity is either mis-declared and/or weight is under or over-declared by 2 tons.

DG misdeclaration either will apply when general cargo is changed to hazardous cargo (dry or refrigerated stowage), or when hazardous cargo is changed to dry. For more information, visit our [site](#). Fines are imposed only with the intent to eliminate re-occurrence.

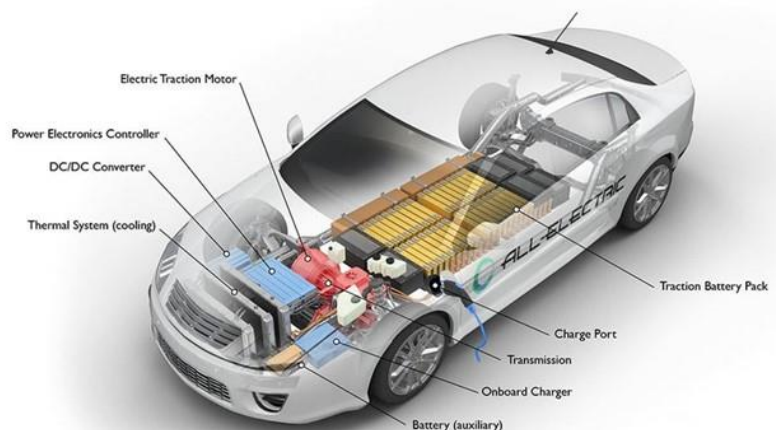

DIFFERENCES BETWEEN BATTERY-POWERED AND HYBRID VEHICLES

Battery Electric Vehicles are electric vehicles that utilize chemical energy that is stored in rechargeable battery packs. Electric vehicles use electric motors instead of, or in addition to, internal combustion engines.

Hybrid Electric Vehicles are powered by an internal combustion engine and an electric motor, which uses energy stored in batteries. A hybrid electric vehicle cannot be plugged in to charge the battery. Instead, the battery is charged through regenerative braking and by the internal combustion engine.

Both vehicles have in common the overall quantity and type of batteries utilized [lead-acid, nickel-metal hydride (NiMH), or lithium-ion (Li-ion)] in comparison to internal combustion engines. **This requires additional review and classification under the IMDG Code.**

Bill of Lading Document Manager Email Subscription/Notification

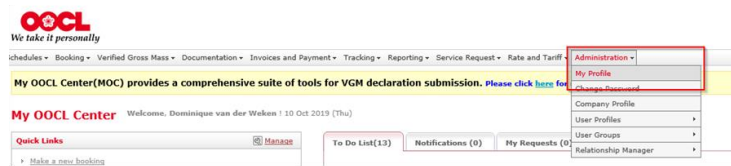
You can subscribe to certain notifications related to your shipments, which can either serve as a reminder or indication when you need to take further action. For example, you can receive notifications when submitting a new booking, rejected VGMs, service requests updates, uploaded document notification to indicate if it has been verified or rejected. The steps below is focused on documentation alerts to further assist your document management.

1 Log into MOC

Log into your “My OOCL Center” at www.oocl.com with your user ID and password.

2 Select “My Profile”

Make the following selection from the main menu bar: Administration → My Profile



3 Go to the “E-Mail Subscriptions” tab

4 Select the appropriate Notifications

Select the notifications you would like to receive and click on the “Save” button on the bottom right-hand corner—do not forget to save prior to exiting the page for subscriptions to take effect.

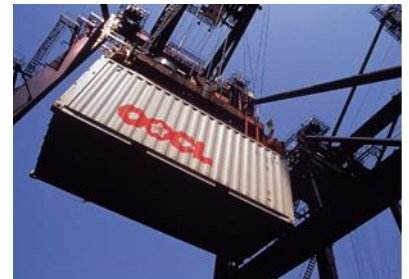

ProTip: ERD vs. DFRD



ERD

Terminal/Rail Earliest Receiving Date

The ERD is the earliest date the marine terminal/rail depot will accept export containers at the gate for the intended vessel. It is key to check with the receiving terminal on the ERD for the individual vessel as the date could have changed after your booking has been made.

Clarification

ERD vs. DFRD

TIP: ERD and DFRD might have different dates. To avoid incurring DD charges, please utilize the **latest date.**

DFRD

OOCL's Demurrage Free Receive Date

The DFRD date is the first date that you may tender an export container without incurring OOCL demurrage. Delivering containers too early will result in OOCL outbound demurrage being charged per our tariff rules, regardless of the marine terminal's earliest receiving date. Outbound demurrage applies equally to merchant and carrier haulage. This information is provided with the Booking Acknowledgement.

Example

In the example below, the terminal's ERD is September 14 and OOCL's DFRD is September 16. To avoid demurrage charges, utilize the latest date, which is OOCL's DFRD of September 16.

| Category | Date |
|----------------|-------------------------------|
| Terminal's ERD | Monday, September 14, 2020 |
| OOCL's DFRD | Wednesday, September 16, 2020 |
