Pine wood import restrictions to China

Please note that effective February 1, 2022, China has issued a new regulation regarding the importation for pine wood. This regulation is to prevent an organism, *Bursaphelenchus xylophilus* (also known as pine wood nematode), from entering China through shipments of pine wood.

Lumber, timber, and logs of pine wood shipped to China are ONLY acceptable via the specific ports listed below **with the proper fumigation validation***:

- Jiangsu Province: Lianyungang (Ganyu Terminal, Yanwei Terminal, New Oriental Terminal), Nanjing (Longtan Terminal, Xinshengxu Terminal)
- Zhejiang Province: Beilun of Ningbo, Zhoushan, Wenzhou, Taizhou
- Fujian Province: Fuzhou (Mawei, Jianguyin)
- Shandong Province: Huangdao (Qingdao), Rizhao, Lanshan of Rizhao, Dongjiakou
- Guangdong Province: Nanhai Sanshan of Foshan, Xingang of Zhaoqing, Huangpu, Dongguan, Wanzai of Zhuhai, Guangao of Shantou

Shipments of any type of pine wood product will not be accepted into China via any other ports apart from the list above.

If you have been shipping pine products via another port other than what is listed, you will need to make arrangements to route your cargo via one of the approved terminals (with proper fumigation) in the future. As noted, this is a new regulation put in place by China and is not an OOCL specific restriction.

This is a requirement for pine wood only, with no impact to any other type of wood being imported into China.

* A few notes on fumigation requirements:

Prior to loading:

- Fumigation and heat treatment are required for pine wood logs and timber. In addition, a laboratory detection for *Bursaphelenchus xylophilus* at origin is required to ensure no pests contains *bursaphelenchus xylophilus* and beetles, etc. This verification of fumigation, heat treatment and lab testing would need to be provided directly to your consignee, and they should be able to provide any more detailed requirements as this will be needed for their local clearance.

After discharging:

- Chinese customs will strictly review the documentations and conduct a lab testing.
- If *Bursaphelenchus xylophilus* is detected, shipments will be returned or destroyed.

Tip: Avoid Booking Delays

To avoid booking process delay, we would recommend for you to update your cargo description to reflect the specific type of wood that you are shipping for destination China.

To update your booking templates within My OOCL Center (MOC):

1. Login to MOC. From the main menu, click on "Booking" and then choose "Templates."
2. Click on the "Modify Template" icon that you wish to update.
3. In the cargo description, add in parenthesis the type of wood you are shipping. Alternatively, if you do not ship pine wood, you can simply include a note stating "(not pine wood)."

Pro-Tip: Customizing booking templates with remarks

Customizing Booking Templates with remarks

With My OOCL Center you can create templates to expedite the submission process in case of frequent, repetitive bookings. In addition, you may also include booking remarks to provide additional information for our customer service review.

- 1 Log into MOC and click on “Booking” and then “Booking Request.” In the section “Remarks for Entire Booking”, you can add special notes. For example, “This commodity does not contain pine wood”. After completing your booking form, click on the “Save as Template” button in the lower right corner.

Cancel Save Template

- 2 Name your booking template. You can also mark it as a favorites and share with other colleagues. Make sure to click on the “Save” button.

- 3 To use an existing template for a new booking, go to the main menu and select “Booking” and then the option “Booking Templates.” When you click on the blue arrow  in the “Actions” column, it will open the template and allow you to submit a new booking. You can still make changes before submitting the booking.

Remarks for Entire Booking Additional Features



Clarifying Commodity Description

To facilitate booking process, you can elaborate on what the cargo description does or does not contain (ex: “Does not contain pine wood”).



Shipper Owned Container or Tank

To facilitate booking process, you can provide the container number in the remarks field.



Marine Terminal Destinations

If the port of discharge has multiple terminals, you can request a specific terminal in the remarks field to clarify booking request.
