

New 24,188 TEU container vessel named "OOCL Piraeus"

On May 30, 2023, OOCL hosted a naming ceremony for another brand new mega vessel "OOCL Piraeus" at the Dalian COSCO KHI Ship Engineering Co., Ltd. (DACKS) shipyard.

OOCL placed an order for a total of twelve 24,188 TEU container vessels in 2020. Of this set of twelve, OOCL Piraeus is the second vessel to be delivered following the delivery of the OOCL Spain earlier in the year.



Vessels in this series are equipped with advanced smart systems and green designs to reduce carbon emissions, improve energy efficiency, and provide long-term navigational safety.

The OOCL Piraeus will join the Asia-Europe service loop LL3 in June 2023.

Environmental, Social and Governance

The Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) aspects of how a company manages these topics are in high demand within the shipping industry.



"Environmental" assesses how a company's activities impact the environment and manage related risks.



"Social" evaluates how a company manages relationships with employees, suppliers, customers, and the communities where it operates.



"Governance" includes a set of rules or principles defining rights, responsibilities and expectations between different stakeholders in the governance of corporations. Investors are increasingly applying these nonfinancial factors as part of their analysis process to identify material risks and growth opportunities.

With about 90% of internationally traded goods carried over the waves, maritime shipping is a major source of greenhouse gas emissions.

According to the International Maritime Organization (IMO), global shipping by sea produces an average of 1 billion metric tons of carbon dioxide (CO2) each year – that means, if the shipping industry were a country, it would be the sixth-largest greenhouse gas emitter.

Given the rise of regulatory requirements and sustainability trends, shipping companies are progressively urged to evaluate their operations in areas such as marine environment protection, impacts on climate change, crew welfare and wellbeing, health and safety standards.

We publish our annual Orient Overseas (International) Limited (OOIL) Sustainability Report that focuses on our continual commitment to proactively address critical environmental challenges.

In addition, the company has rolled out various measures to protect the health and safety of our employees.

MOC: Submitting VGM



MOC- My OOCL Center

Submitting Verified Gross Mass (VGM)

A container without a VGM is not allowed to load onto the vessel. The shipper must ensure that the VGM is provided sufficiently in advance to the ocean carrier and/or port terminal in order to meet the local regulatory requirements. To facilitate VGM submission, My OOCL Center (MOC) provides you with 2 options.




VGM Submission Options:


- Option 1- VGM Declaration (MOC UI Data Input): used for individual booking with a few containers.
- Option 2- VGM Form and Submission (excel download): used for bookings with many containers.



For option 1 to submit VGM, log into MOC, and click on "Verified Gross Mass" option from the main menu, then select "VGM Declaration."

Make sure to select the appropriate weighing methods. Please ensure that the **authorized party** adds their name in capital letters along with utilizing the calendar icon to select the cargo weight date. The e-signature is required.





Method 2- A calculator will pop up. Enter the weight of the cargo. Choose unit in Pounds or Kilogram. Add the tare weight provided by the calculator by clicking on it. This will be your VGM.

Once you have provided the information, click on the "Next" button. User will have the ability to either cancel or submit. To continue, click on the "I agree" box and then "VGM Declaration" button.



For option 2 to submit VGM, click on "Verified Gross Mass" option from the main menu, then select "VGM Form and Submission." Click on the "Download OOCL VGM Excel File Template. Input the respective container and VGM information on the excel file. Save file and upload to MOC and click on the "Upload" button.



Step 1: Login to MOC with your user ID and password.

Step 2: In the middle of the page, you can perform a search by clicking on the "Shipment Details" option and input the booking number. Then click on the "Search" button.
