On June 6, 2023, OOCL hosted a naming ceremony for another brand new mega vessel "OOCL Turkiye" at the Nantong COSCO KHI Ship Engineering Co., Ltd. ("NACKS") shipyard.

OOCL placed an order for a total of twelve 24,188 TEU container vessels in 2020.

Being a part of our strategic plan for further growth in Asia -Europe trade, "OOCL Turkiye" will join her sister vessels "OOCL Spain" and "OOCL Piraeus" in serving the Asia-Europe LL3 service loop.

The latest developed energy-saving bulbous bow is one of the many green features in this series of mega-vessel.

Vessel Tracking




The OOCL website features vessel tracking solutions indicating potential delays such as congestion, weather, or holidays.


To begin your search:

- 1. Go to oocl.com.
- 2. Click on the drop-down menu and select "Vessel".
- 3. Type the vessel name.
- 4. Click on the "Search" button.

The search results will provide details on the arrival and departure on a port level. If there is a delay, it will be indicated in the remarks column.

Reports- Ad Hoc and Subscription

My OOCL Center provides you with visibility to monitor your shipments. With a variety of data columns to choose from, you can either download an ad hoc report or you can schedule a subscription with the options to receive it on a daily, weekly or monthly basis.



Ad Hoc Reports

Login into MOC and click on "Reporting" option from the main menu and then "Report Templates." If you have an existing report template that is on a schedule, but you would like to pull an ad hoc report, then go to step 2.





To download the report, under the "Actions" section, click on the "Email Report" button.






New Reports and Subscription

Login into MOC and click on "Reporting" option from the main menu and then "Report Templates." Then click on the "Add Template" button.

PROTIP A Reset Password

My OOCL Center (MOC) password reset can be self-serviced by following the instructions listed below. User will receive a temporary password which will prompt to set a permanent, strong password.

- 1. Visit our site www.oocl.com.
- 2. Click on "My OOCL Center" button on the top right-hand corner of the main page.
- 3. Click on "Forgot your User ID /Password" hyperlink.
- 4. Enter your MOC User ID and Email address.
- 5. Click on "Request New Password" button.



- An email from no-reply@cargosmart.com with user's temporary password will be sent to associated email address. Log in to My OOCL Center with temporary password.
- Please note that user will need to manually input the temporary password and do not copy and paste as the system won't accept it.
 User will be prompted to change the temporary password.
- New password should consist of the following requirements:
 - 1. It must contain a combination of letters, numbers and a minimum length of 8 characters.
 - 2. A combination at least 3 out of the 4 criteria: upper case letter, lower case letter, numeric digital and special symbols.
 - 3. Part of username/ user ID/company name, consecutive letter or number combination (abc, 123, etc) cannot be used.

Password Guidelines



A new password must contain a combination of letters and numbers, and a minimum length of 8 characters.



A combination of at least 3 out of the following 4 criteria: upper case letter, lower case letter, numeric digit, and special symbols.



Part of username and company name, simple and consecutive letter combination, cannot be used in new strong password.
