

OOCL.com provides solutions to track and trace your containers by either booking, bill of lading or container number without the need of a login or password.

Step by step tracking guide

- 1. Go to OOCL.com.
- Under "Tracking" Tab, select the "Tracking Type" as either "B/L#", "Booking#" or "Container#".
- 3. Input the respective information (BL, container or booking number) and click on the "Search" button.
- 4. Complete the CAPTCHA security verification by sliding the puzzle.



Administrator Adding a new user

Once your company has a registered account with My OOCL Center, the administrator can add new users who can access MOC's shipment modules. Please follow the below steps for adding new users.


The administrator will log into MOC and click on the "Administration" option from the main menu. Then select "User Profiles" and click on "Create User Profile".



Fill in the required fields (*) for "User Profile" and "Preferences" tabs.



Then click the "Access" tab. Click "Standard Access" and then the button () to move it to the right column. Then click the "Confirm" Button. Blue checkbox shows user's Access functions. De-select if necessary and click on "Save."



*The system will auto generate the user id and a temporary password to the user's email address.

PROTIP Rail Pick Up Number

The easiest way to obtain a rail pick up number is via our My OOCL Center (MOC).

In order for the rail pick up number to be available online it is required that:


- 1. You are a legal party of the bill of lading.
- 2. The customs status is released and has been received in our system.
 - For cargo moving on an IT, the IT arrival is done once container has arrived at the final destination.
- 3. All charges are paid, and the shipment is fully released by OOCL.



Log into your "My OOCL Center" at www.oocl.com with your user ID and password.

2 Select "Shipment Details"

Near the bottom of the screen, select "Shipment Details" and input your B/L Number and click on the "Search" button.



3 Go to Intermodal Details at Destination

Upon search results page, you will find the column "Rail Pick Up Number" towards the bottom of the page under "Intermodal Details at Destination."
