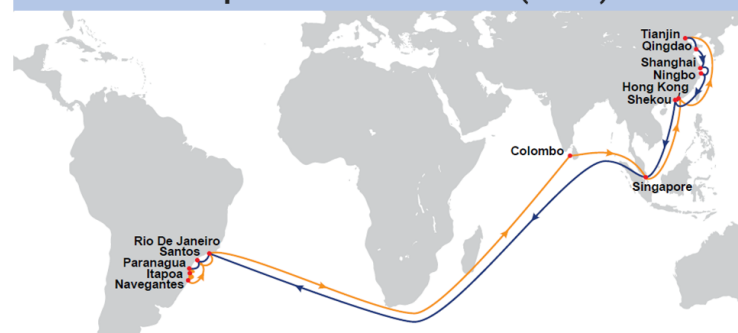

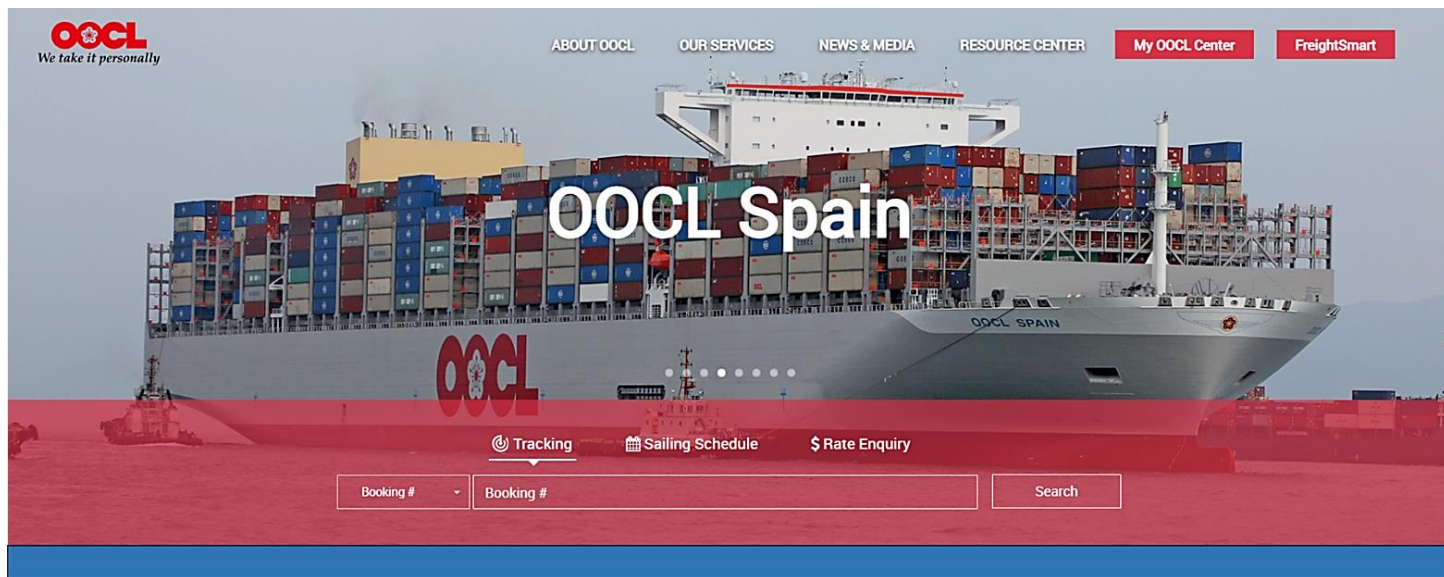

Step by step tracking guide

1. Go to OOCL.com.
2. Under "Tracking" Tab, select the "Tracking Type" as either "B/L#", "Booking#" or "Container#".
3. Input the respective information (BL, container or booking number) and click on the "Search" button.
4. Complete the CAPTCHA security verification by sliding the puzzle.

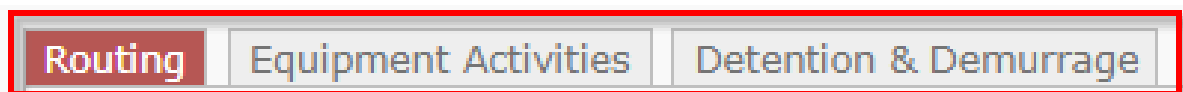

OOCL.com Tracking Captcha

When tracking on OOCL.com, users will be required to complete the CAPTCHA security verification. This can be done by rotating the puzzle wheel until the letters "OOCL" are aligned.

1 The CAPTCHA will appear with some of the letters in the word "OOCL" unaligned. The user should drag the slider bar to the right which will rotate the wheel with the purpose of aligning the "OOCL" letters within the CAPTCHA.

Drag the slider to fit the puzzle piece



Please slide to verify

2 Rotate the out of place letters until the letters "OOCL" are aligned. This will verify the CAPTCHA security and will then take users to OOCL.com Tracking module.
