OOCL Names its Third 16,828 TEU Vessel—OOCL Sunflower



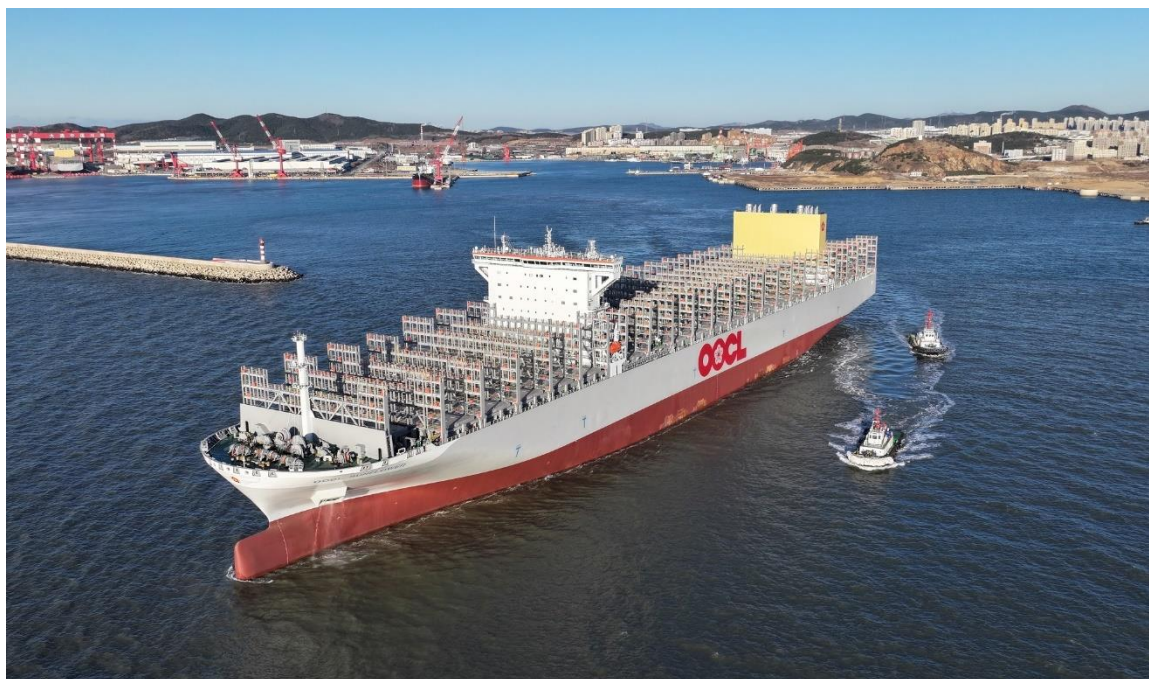

"OOCL Sunflower" was named by Mrs. Jenny King, Director and General Manager of INTCO Recycling Resources Co., Ltd. This series of latest eco-friendly vessels, each with a capacity of 16,828 TEU, incorporates cutting-edge technology that delivers exceptional intelligence, superior

environmental performance, and outstanding operational efficiency. Designed to not only meet but exceed current environmental standards, this series underscores OOCL's commitment to sustainable development.

Mr. Michael Xu, Director and Member of Executive Committee of OOCL, said at the ceremony: "We are confident that this ship will significantly enhance our ability to connect the world and serve our customers in future voyages. As we look ahead to 2025, the shipping industry is set to face both opportunities and challenges. 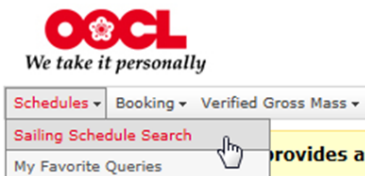

My OOCL Center (MOC) provides important administrative features such as the ability to update company address as well as adding new users to have access to manage shipments within the same company.

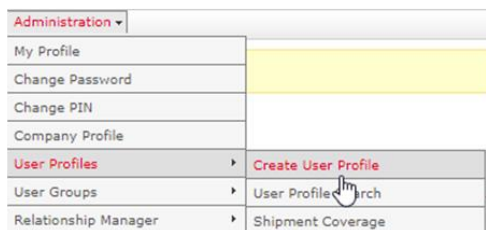
Changing Company Address

It is important for your company to maintain accurate and current address on My OOCL Center (MOC). This will assist our customer service team to process your bookings faster and if you order bill of lading paper online it will assist to ship it to the correct address.

- 1 Log into MOC and click on “Administration” option from the menu then select “Company profile” to identify your company’s administrator. The contact information of the administrator will be available under the “Administrator” section.
- 2 The administrator must login to MOC. In the main menu, select “Administration” option and then click on the “Company Profile.” Make the required changes to update your address and click on the “Save” button at the bottom of the screen.

Adding New Users (For Company Administrators only)

- 1 The Administrator will log into MOC and click on the “Administration” menu. Then select “User Profiles” and click “Create User Profile”.



- 2 Under the “Primary Information” tab, fill out the required fields (*).
- 3 After providing Primary Information, then click on the “Preferences” tab. Select the “Preferred Time Zone” and “Preferred E-mail Format” fields. HTML Format is the most popular.
- 4 Then click on the “Access” tab. Select the “Standard Access” option and click on the arrow button to move to the Standard Access to the selected column. Make sure to click on the “Confirm” Button. Select the user’s Access functions and click on the “Save” button at the bottom. The user ID will be displayed in the online profile. The system will auto generate the user ID and a temporary password will be sent to the user’s email address.
