

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I search for invoices?

- A: You can search invoices using:
- √ Invoice Number or Bill of Lading (B/L) Number
- √ Date Range (invoice date or due date, up to 2 months per query)
- √ Status Filter (e.g., Outstanding, Overpaid, Settled)
- √ Invoice Type (outbound or inbound)
- √ Customer Name (for invoices under a specific customer)
- √ Payment Location or Payee

Q: How far back can I search for invoices?

A: Invoices from September 2023 onward are available.

Q: Who can see my invoices?

A: Invoice visibility is restricted—only authorized payers can view their respective invoices.

Q: What appears in the default search results?

A: The system shows the latest 10 invoices from the past month.

Q: Can I view invoices in my local currency?

A: Yes, you can switch to local currency for invoice amounts.

Q: How do I download an invoice?

A: Click the invoice number to download the PDF.

Did you know: administrators can add new users to their existing MOC accounts?

Within My OOCL Center (MOC), company administrators are able to add users to their existing MOC accounts. This allows the new user to quickly access MOC and start managing their shipments.


How to create new user accounts:

 From the main menu on the welcome page, click Administration→User Profiles→Create User Profile.





2. You will then be prompted to create a MOC profile for the new user, by entering an email address. Then click "Next".



3. Fill out the new user details, complete the CAPTCHA puzzle, then click "Submit". A pop-up will appear advising the account is created an an activation email sent to the new user. Additionally at this point, you can configure the new user's MOC permissions, if necessary.







Track & Trace on OOCL.com



OOCL.com provides solutions to track and trace your containers by either booking, bill of lading or container number without the need of a login or password.



- 1. Go to OOCL.com.
- Under "Tracking" Tab, select the "Tracking Type" as either "B/L#", "Booking#" or "Container#".
- 3. Input the respective information (BL, container or booking number) and click on the "Search" button.



MOC- My OOCL Center




My OOCL Center allows users to View, Amend, Approve Draft Bill of Lading. For Seaway and Original Bill of Ladings users can also print the documentation online.

To get started, log into My OOCL Center (MOC) here with your sign-in credentials.

Select Documentation

From the main menu, make the following selection: Documentation →
Bill of Lading→ B/L View and Print.

You can search by BL number or Type.
When searching via the BL number,
only input the numeric portion.



Multiple actions to select

Referencing the "Actions" column choose your desired action from the available icons for the respective BL.

- Reviewing your Draft B/Ls: You are able to requests an amendment or approve the BL.
- Printing copies: For drafts and seaway bills of lading, you can use everyday white paper.
- Printing Original Bills of Lading –OOCL stationary is required and can also be ordered via MOC.
- Customizing the number of prints The number of available copies to print are shown on the Print Available reference of the Bill of Lading.








OOCL.com Tracking Captcha

When tracking on OOCL.com, users will be required to complete the CAPTCHA security verification. This can be done by rotating the puzzle wheel until the letters "OOCL" are aligned.

- The CAPTCHA will appear with some of the letters in the word "OOCL" unaligned. The user should drag the slider bar to the right which will rotate the wheel with the purpose of aligning the "OOCL" letters within the CAPTCHA.
- Rotate the out of place letters until the letters "OOCL" are aligned. This will verify the CAPTCHA security and will then take users to OOCL.com Tracking module.










National Maritime Day
