OOCL Recognized as a Top Performer for the Clean Vessel Incentive Program

OOCL is pleased to announce that we have been recognized by the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey as a top 2025 performer for the Clean Vessel Incentive (CVI) in the category of average vessel speed reduction.

The CVI Program is based on a scoring system, which awards points for Vessel Speed Reduction (VSR), a component that requires vessels to slow-steam at 10 knots or less from 20 nautical miles (nm) outside of the Territorial Sea Line, and a vessel's Environmental Ship Index (ESI) score.

This recognition highlights OOCL's continued efforts to operate more efficiently while supporting more sustainable ocean shipping practices.

The VSR component rewards ships that slow down throughout the year and extend the area for speed reduction into the harbor, thereby reducing air pollutants, as well as CO2 emissions and the risk of fatal strikes on whales.

OOCL was presented with a plaque award during the 2026 Ports Sustainability Summit at the Cape Liberty Cruise Port in Bayonne, New Jersey, commemorating our achievement.

Being recognized as a top performer reflects the tangible steps OOCL is taking to align operational excellence with our environmental goals.

Document Type Update: IMDG Dangerous Goods Declaration (DGD)

When uploading your Dangerous Goods (DG) declaration form via My OOCL Center (MOC), please utilize the new document type under Shipment Folder called “IMDG Dangerous Goods Declaration (DGD)”.

Updates effective June 1, 2026

When you upload this document type to MOC, please select and use the “IMDG Dangerous Goods Declaration (DGD)” option going forward. The previous type “DG certificate for international transport” is no longer available.



For New DG Bookings

- Required document type will be IMDG Dangerous Goods Declaration (DGD).
- Customers should upload the same DG declaration form, but under the new document type.
- System configuration will prevent selection of the old document type (DG certificate for international transport) to assist with correct document type usage.

Important Note

- DG form content remains unchanged – only the document type name has changed.

Helpful Documentation Information

OOCL's Documentation team is dedicated to delivering timely, accurate, and reliable support to help keep your shipments moving smoothly. From processing shipping instructions and issuing bills of lading to handling amendments, the team plays a critical role in supporting your shipping needs every step of the way. With a strong focus on service, efficiency, and accuracy, we are committed to providing customers with the documentation support they can depend on.

Please find below helpful information regarding documentation services:

Shipping Instructions

Shipping instructions are processed within 2 hours of receipt during business hours. Upon completion of the Bill of Lading (BL), OOCL will provide customers with a copy so data can be reviewed for accuracy.

Bill of Lading

- **Issuance**

Onboard Vessel BLs are released within 24 hours of vessel sailing, while Received for Shipment or Onboard Rail BLs are released within 24 hours after the proforma BL is completed and delivered.

- **Amendments**

BL amendment requests are processed within 4 hours if received during working hours unless further clarification is needed.

Change of Destination

Change of destination must be requested three business days prior to either the arrival of vessel at final discharge port, or the arrival of container(s) at final inland hub as long as the request is to change the door move destination city only. Inland intermodal hub needs to remain unchanged. The requested new destination must have a rate on file. One working day review time may be required for change of destination request.

Letter of Credit Requirements

Upon request, our Documentation team can prepare vessel certificates to satisfy Letter of Credit requirements. The request can be submitted via the respective email address [here](#). Certificates are issued at the time when cargo is confirmed on board as it may include vessel related information.

Electronic Bills of Lading

Electronic bills of lading (eBL) is an alternative method to improve the efficiency and security of paper original bills of lading. For more information, visit our [site](#).
