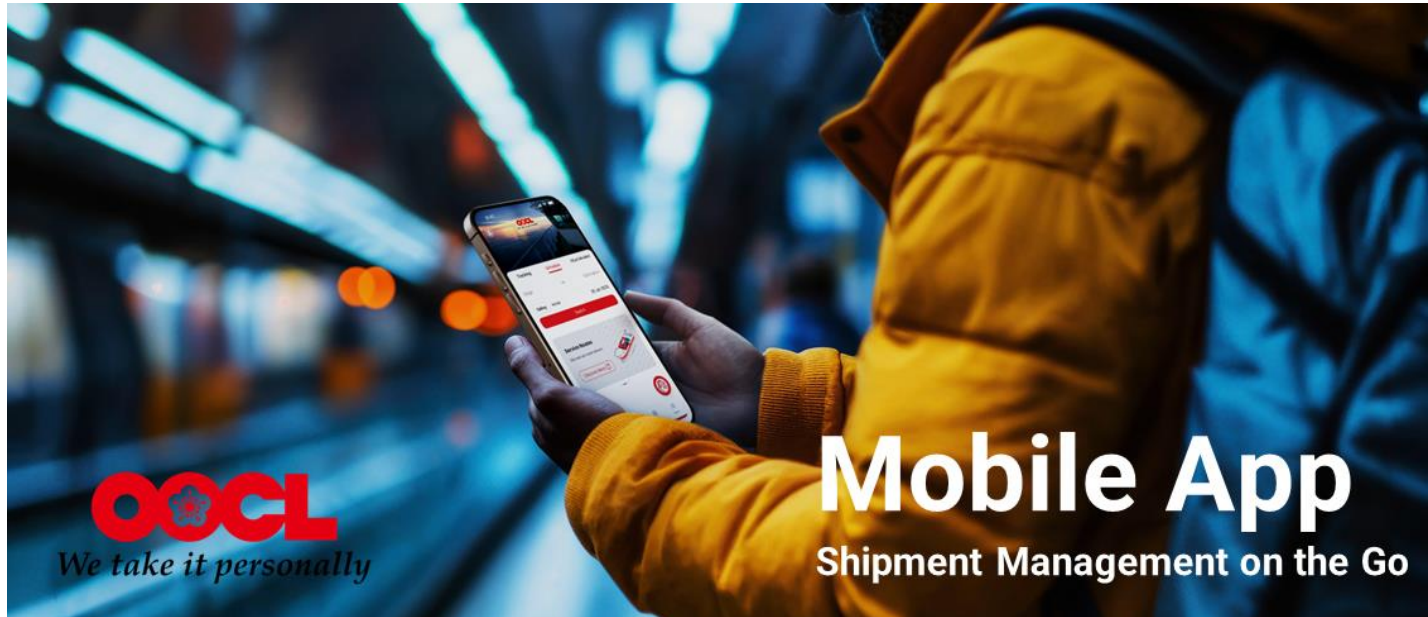

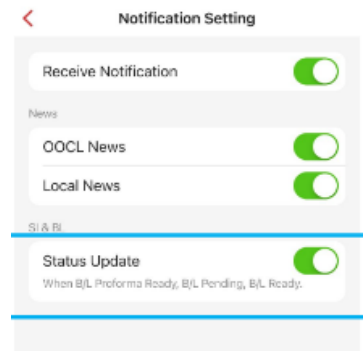

Added to the OOCL Mobile App, Notification settings users will be able to turn on the BL Status Notification feature and receive BL Status update for:

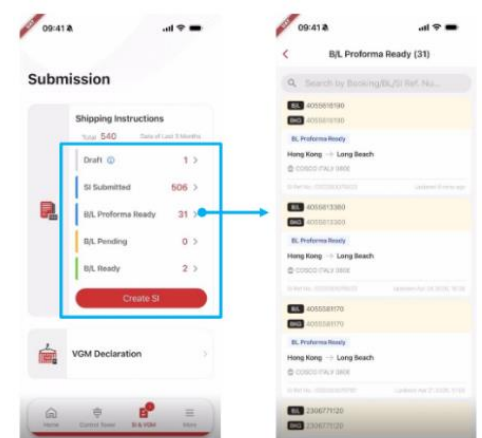

How to Submit Your Government Export Number via MOC

Adding your Government Export Number to Shipping Instructions is quick and simple with our online tool—My OOCL Center (MOC). In the SmartDoc Shipping Instructions module, you can easily include required export details—such as an Automated Export System (AES) number—during the submission process, helping you fulfill your documentation requirements efficiently.

Follow these simple steps to add your Government Export Number when submitting your Shipping Instructions via SmartDoc:

1. Log in to MOC using your username and password.
2. From the main screen, select “Documentations” → “SmartDoc (SI Submission)” from the menu bar.
3. Enter your booking number in the search bar, then click “Create SI”.
4. In the “Shipment Info and Parties” tab, enter your Shipping Instruction details. Under User Reference Type and Number, select Government Export Number from the drop-down list or type it in manually.
5. Enter the number and click “Add” to include it in your Shipping Instructions.

For added support, you can refer to the SmartDoc user guidelines available within the “SmartDoc” module, making it even easier to complete your submission with confidence.

My OOCL Center's Sailing Schedule Search Feature

Within My OOCL Center (MOC), the Sailing Schedule feature provides customers with advanced sorting and filtering capabilities, along with cargo cutoff and shipping instruction (SI) cutoff information. Customers can also export search results to Excel as well as initiate the booking process directly from the same screen.



To access and utilize the feature:

1. Log into MOC with your username and password.
2. On the menu bar, go to "Plan & Book" and then click "Sailing Schedule".
3. Slowly start typing your origin and destination and then choose the cities from the dropdown.
4. Ensure all fields with a red asterisk have the correct information.
5. Click "Find Sailing Schedule".
