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OOCL Wisdom Completes First Green Methanol Bunkering and Begins Maiden Voyage

OOCL Wisdom, currently the world's largest methanol dual-fuel container vessel, completed its first green methanol bunkering and commenced its maiden voyage at Qingdao port on July 3, 2026.

OOCL Wisdom is the first in a series of seven methanol dual-fuel container vessels. With a maximum capacity of 24,168 TEU, it is currently the world's largest methanol dual-fuel container vessel.



Mr. Peter Pan, Director of Trades of OOCL, said: "OOCL Wisdom completed its first green methanol bunkering and commenced its maiden voyage to Europe at Qingdao Port, representing a significant achievement of the deepening collaboration between OOCL and Shandong Port Group, and reflecting OOCL's steadfast commitment to green and low-carbon development, digital intelligence and sustainability. It serves as a centralized repository for shipment-related documents, allowing users to upload files such as DG documents or automobile titles to OOCL and download OOCL-provided documents, including Arrival Notices and copies of bills of lading.



Latest Enhancements

Search Multiple Shipments at Once

- Search up to 20 bookings, bills of lading or containers at a time.

New Advanced Search Feature

- Use the new advanced search feature to populate multiple shipments at once filtered by options such as cargo nature and final destination.

All Documents in Central Place

- Visibility of all documents uploaded to OOCL, and all documents provided by OOCL in one central location instead of separate tabs.
